## Introduction

Get started with your Yealink MeetingBoard (Windows).

## Before You Begin

- Ensure you have installed the MCore-OPS-G2T on Yealink MeetingBoard. For how to install, refer to: [MCore-OPS-G2T](#).

- 💡 • If you boot your Yealink MeetingBoard for the first time without installing the MCore-OPS-G2T, then you will enter the Android setup wizard of Yealink MeetingBoard.
- If you install the MCore-OPS-G2T after you complete the Yealink MeetingBoard's setup wizard, then on any platform under the Android system, Yealink MeetingBoard will automatically enter Windows mode.
- If you need to exit Windows mode, uninstall the MCore-OPS-G2T, tap the sidebar menu button, select **Settings**, select **UC Provider**, and select the platform you want to switch to.

## Power on Yealink MeetingBoard

1. On the right rear panel of Yealink MeetingBoard, toggle the rocker switch to the "I" position to power on the device.



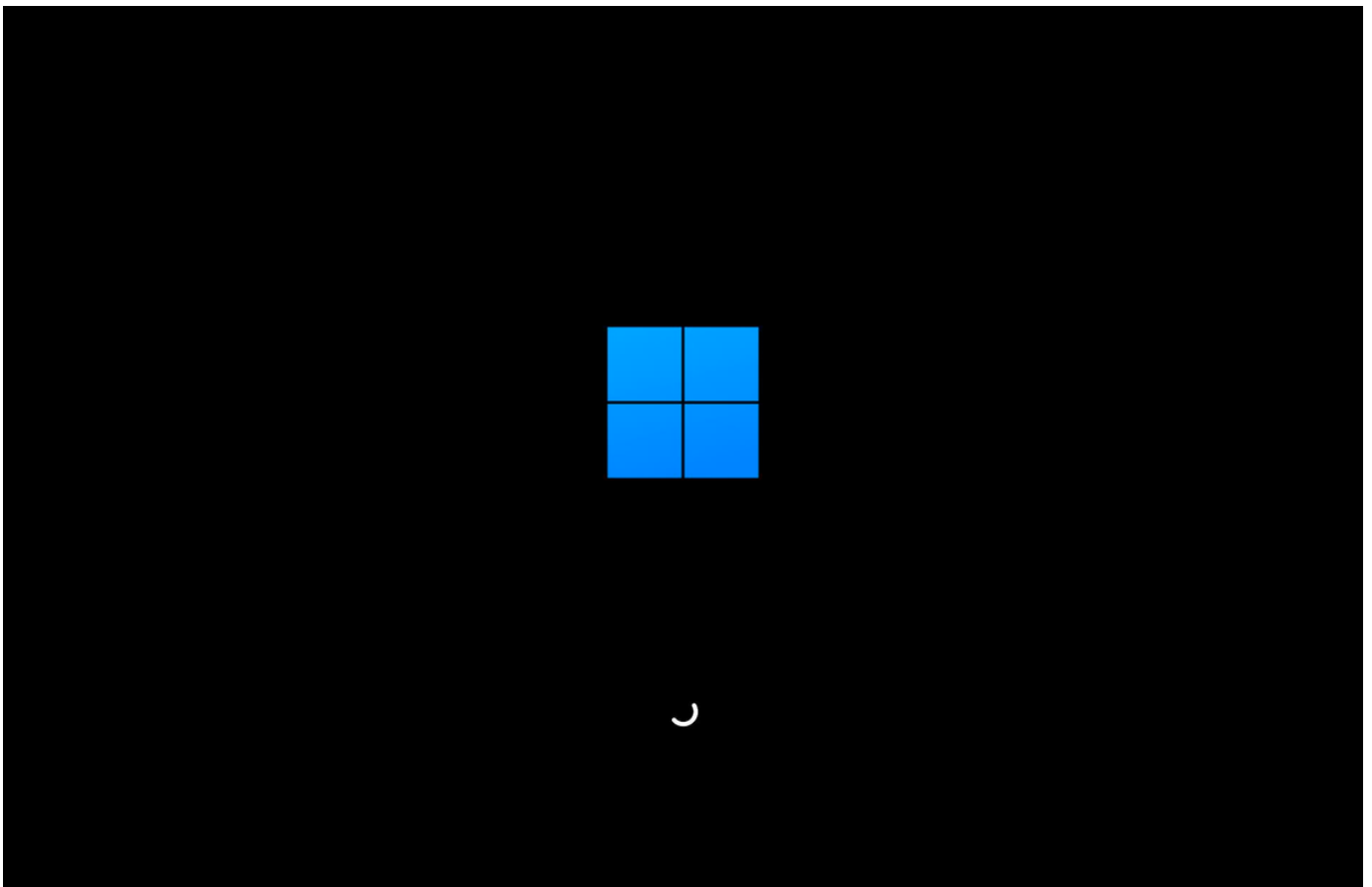
2. (Optional) Press F2 to enter the setup procedure; press F3 to enter the boot manager interface; or press ESC to return to the front page.

Enable BIOS administrator password for Increased security

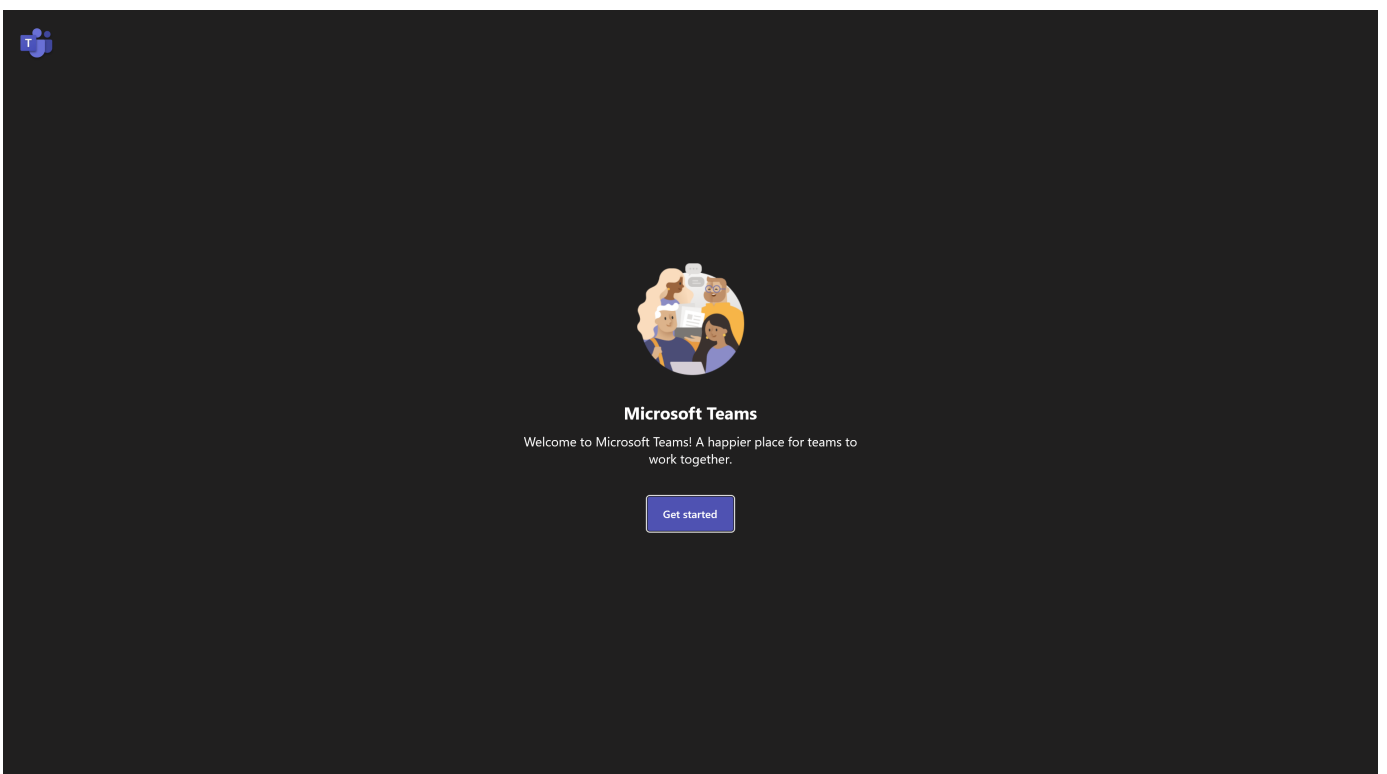
! A keyboard is needed to connect to the OPS in this step.

3. Wait for a few seconds, and you will go to the Windows startup interface.

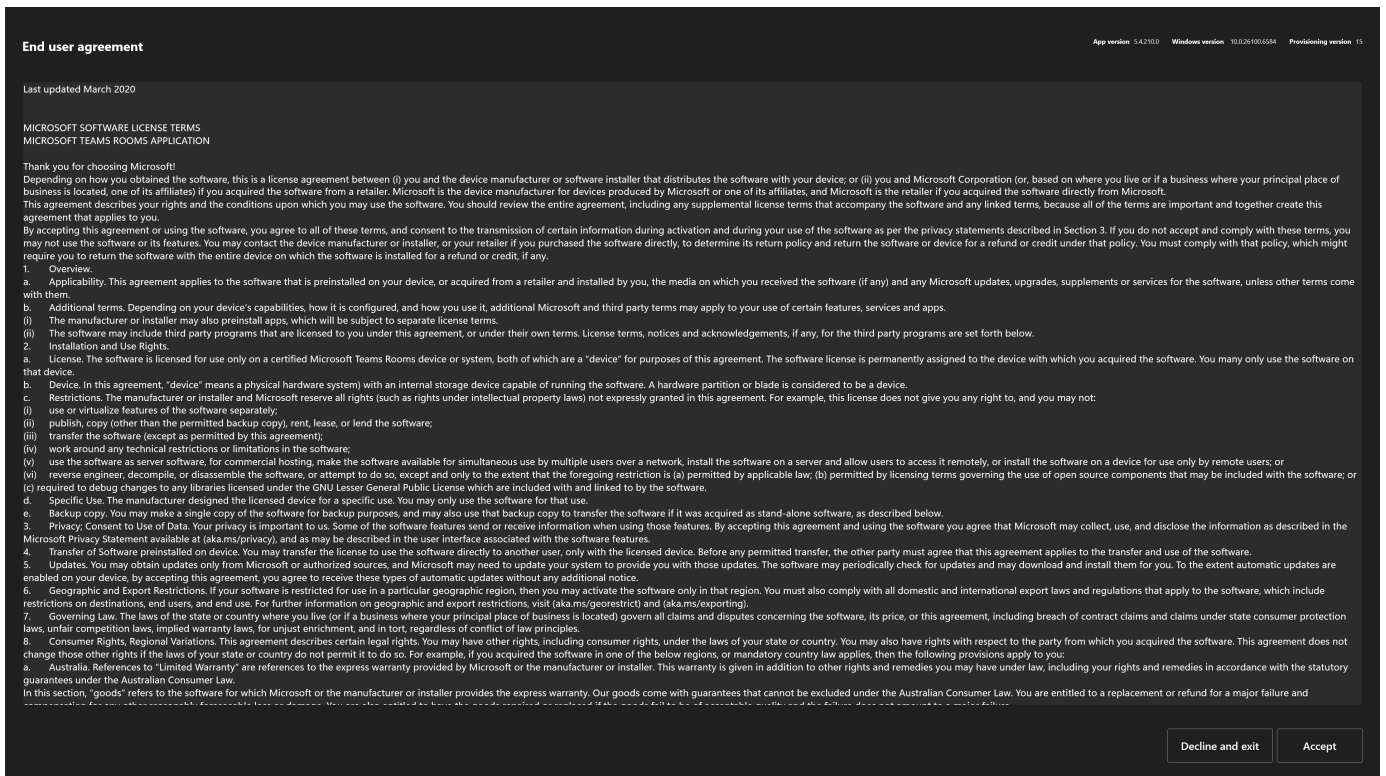


## Log in to Microsoft Teams

1. On the **Welcome** page, select **Get started**. The **End User Agreement** appears.

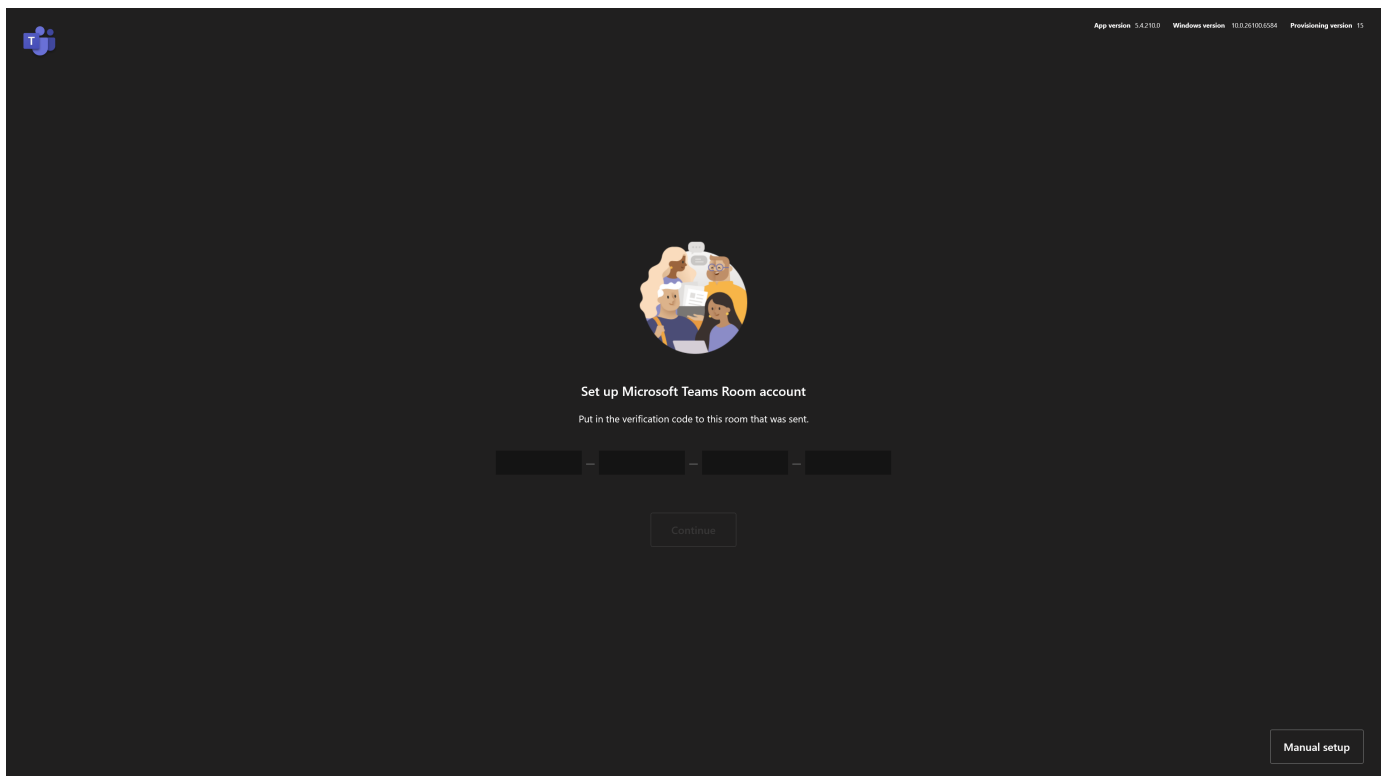


2. On the **End User Agreement** page, select **Accept**. The **Set up Microsoft Teams Rooms account** page will appear.



3. On the **Set up Microsoft Teams Rooms account** page, put in the one-time password that was provided to you by the IT administrator, and then select **Continue**.

(Optional) If you do not have a one-time password, you can select **Manual setup**, and the **Account Setup** page appears.

4. On the **Account setup** page, put in the email and password that are used for the device in the **Email** and **Password** fields. If you don't know what those are, please contact your IT admin.
